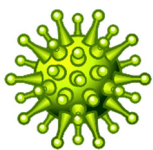

ON THE DAY

- Use the toilet before you come
- Bring face covering, tissues, hand gel, a drink, a book to read to your child
- Wear waterproof clothing as you will queue outside (if it is really wet we have a Plan B)
- No scooters, no bikes – please leave buggies at home if at all possible
- Only 1 adult to attend with each child and No other children
- *If, after reading the NHS website*, you think your child may need an injectable vaccine instead of nasal spray vaccine, please make sure your child is wearing a T-shirt.*
- Come on time – not early, not late
- Queue **OUTSIDE** the building
- Follow Social Distancing signs
- **DO NOT ENTER THE BUILDING until escorted by a member of staff**
- **Adults must wear a face covering at all times inside the building**



Please follow the COVID RULES to keep staff and other patients safe:
YOU MUST CANCEL YOUR APPOINTMENT IF

- Your or a member of your household/family have tested positive for Covid-19 and have not reached the end of your isolation period
- You or a member of your household/family are waiting for a test result for Covid-19
- you have travelled within the last 14 days to a country which is no longer on the Government's safe travel list
- You have been in contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19 or been in isolation with a suspected case within the last 14 days
- You have COVID-19 symptoms of
 - A high temperature or fever
 - A new continuous cough
 - A loss or alteration of taste or smell
